Welcome to Indiana University Southeast.

Your next step to success is to attend Transfer Student Orientation. As a transfer student, your needs are different than those of a first-year college student, so we've designed a program to address the questions you might have about your experience at IU Southeast.

Orientation is required for all degree-seeking students new to IU Southeast. It is your opportunity to become familiar with your new college environment and to learn how to be successful at IU Southeast. Attendees can expect to receive the following during Orientation:

- Information about how transfer credits apply to various degree programs
- Tools and tips for success toward graduation
- Academic advising in your area of study
- UCard (your official student identification card)

Family members are invited and encouraged to participate in Orientation, since their support is crucial to the success of any student entering IU Southeast.

Steps to Register for Orientation

1. Go online to register

Sign up for Orientation online beginning in March. You'll need your 10-digit student identification number to enter the registration system. Visit ius.edu/orientation.

2. Print the Orientation confirmation

You will know your reservation has been finalized when you receive the online confirmation message. Print this message for your records and bring it to your Orientation.

Before Orientation or Advising

1. Create your IU Network Account at the Account Management System website at <https://itaccounts.iu.edu>. You will need your University Identification number printed at the top of your admissions letter.
2. View and print a copy of your Transfer Credit Report (TCR) and Academic Advisement Report (AAR). These reports show how your previous coursework has transferred to IU Southeast and how those credits apply to your degree program.

You may access your TCR at <http://onestart.iu.edu>, then click on the "Go to Student Center" link, then the "My Academics & Grades" link, and choose the "View Academic Credit Report" link. The AAR can be viewed by selecting the "View My Advising Report" link under "My Academics & Grades". Please print the TCR and AAR and bring them to your advising session.

3. Complete placement tests, if you did not transfer college level English or math credits to IU Southeast (see your transfer credit report). You will need to complete placement tests before meeting with your academic advisor. Visit the Student Development Center's Web site at www.ius.edu/sdc for a placement test schedule.

4. Send all final transcripts to the Admissions office after grades are recorded at your previous institution. You will not be able to register for future semesters without this information and your academic advising session will not be as successful.
